### THIS MONTH'S KEP CHALLENGE



The last update to our process for scheduling natural rubber latex tubing production was in 2008 - but successful growth calls for continuous lean improvements. Due to the increasing demand for our natural rubber latex tubing products, we determined that our process for scheduling natural rubber latex tubing production was not as lean as it could be.

We got to work, forming a Kaizen team that would tackle this challenge. The team outlined goals for this event, including reducing overall time spent scheduling the production of our natural rubber latex tubing, error proofing the scheduling process, reducing the amount of handwritten entries involved with scheduling, and updating all documents used by the scheduler.
